

T – Ball Rules 2010

- Games will last for one (1) hour and a half. No new inning will start after one (1) hour and 15 minutes.
- Coaches will concentrate on teaching the fundamentals of the game: proper fielding, throwing, batting, and base running.
- Field positions will consist of pitcher, first base, second base, short stop, and third base. The remainder of the roster will be spaced evenly in the outfield.
- Batters will have a maximum of 10 attempts to hit the ball each at bat. The first five attempts will be pitches from the coach, and if the hitter does not hit the ball, the ‘T’ will be brought out. No more than 5 more swings at the ball on the “T” will be allowed.
- When the batter hits the ball in fair territory, only one base per hit will be allowed.
- The first half of the season, the team at bat will bat once through the batting order. If a batter is put out by fielding, then that player must leave the field of play, but the out will not be counted.
- The second half of the season, the team at bat will get 3 fielded outs, or once through the order, which ever comes first.
- There will be no strikeouts. Batters who fail to hit the ball in 10 attempts will return to the bench, but no out will be counted.
- Base runners will be taught to run through first base, hitting the orange safety base and turn to the right to return to the base.
- Runners may not lead off
- Runners may not steal.
- No score will be kept.
